Attachment A

A tentative agreement for a successor contract was reached between the City of Park Ridge and the International Union of Operating Engineers, Local 150 on or about January 21, 2013. It was the City's clear understanding that, as part of the tentative agreement, bargaining unit employees would begin paying 13% of the applicable medical insurance premium commencing May 1, 2013. Union attorney Deanna Distasio advised the City's labor counsel that the unit had ratified the agreement.

The City subsequently prepared and sent a draft of the new agreement to the Union's counsel on February 15, 2013. The Union was provided with a redline version showing all changes to the prior contract, as well as a clean version of the new agreement. The changes to the insurance contribution clause were clearly evident in the redline version provided to the Union. On February 20, 2013, the Union attorney advised the City that the draft was acceptable, and asked when the City Council would ratify. Based upon the Union's representation, the City submitted this agreement to the City Council for approval.

The agreement prepared by the City, and approved by the Union's counsel, was scheduled for consideration by the City Council Public Works Committee as a Whole on March 11, and the full Council on March 18, 2013. The City Council approved the agreement in a public session on or about April 1, 2013. The Mayor subsequently vetoed the contract, and the City Council subsequently overrode his veto on May 6, 2013.

The Union did not advise the City of any alleged discrepancy with the new draft agreement until April 5, 2013, well after the City Council's initial approval of the agreement. The Union now asserts that the agreement it approved on February 20, 2013 is not correct, and refuses to approve or otherwise sign the agreement. Such refusal constitutes bad faith bargaining in violation of Section 10(b)(4) of the Illinois Public Labor Relations Act ("TPLRA"), and an improper refusal to sign a collective bargaining agreement in violation of Section 10(b)(8) of the IPLRA.
