On the afternoon of June 1st, 2015, our department responded to a serious traffic crash involving a 5 year old severely autistic child that had run into traffic on Palatine Road. When officers arrived on the scene, the situation was grave for the child suffering from severe head and spinal injuries.

Fearing the worse, our department activated the S.T.A.R. Team. Seven members of the team responded to the scene quickly and within 4 hours from the first team member's arrival, the road was reopened and the investigation at the scene was complete.

The child was airlifted from Northwest Community to Children's Memorial in Chicago, but the injuries were so severe that he passed away early on June 2nd, 2015. Please pass along my thanks to Sgt. Kirk Ashleman for his assistance during this investigation.
