Background:

Alderman Moran suggested at a previous meeting that Holiday Lights be brought back for discussion, and Alderman Shubert concurred.

Staff has learned that a group of volunteers would be willing to install lights around the entire Library Triangle. Public Works crews, using standard time whenever possible and overtime as necessary, would then complete the project. Project costs would be approximately \$5,000 - \$7,000 for lights and potentially an additional \$5,000 in overtime.

The following is a summary of a survey, conducted by the Park Ridge Chamber of Commerce, of local Chambers of Commerce on the funding and installation of holiday lights:

Buffalo Grove Village is responsible Round Lake Area Village is responsible Glenview Village is responsible Lincolnwood Village is responsible Mt. Prospect Village is responsible

Grayslake 50/50 split with Chamber and Village (\$10,000 each)

Edison Park Chamber pays local fireman to light up train station each year

Winnetka-Northfield Village is responsible, Chamber use to provide fundraising support, but does

not anymore. Park District provides support to light one of the local parks Glencoe

Village is responsible but Chamber helps organize a brief ceremony the Friday

after Thanksgiving

Rolling Meadows Village is responsible Wilmette

Village is responsible but Chamber helps organize a tree lighting ceremony
