

PADDLE TENNIS COURTS

- Two courts along with warming shelter and spectator waiting area
- Heaters beneath a raised aluminum surface —
 less than half the size of a standard tennis court —
 keep ice and snow away, and lights allow for evening
 matches
- One of only a handful of current public Paddle Tennis locations in the northwest suburbs
- Great transition sport for tennis players to continue playing a racquet sport in the winter
- Great way to keep active and have fun during the winter months
- A sport for all age groups

Lacrosse has grown over the last 4 years in Park Ridge with more than 233 boys and girls participating locally in this sport. Through the Youth Campus referendum, Park Ridge Park District will be excited to offer the very first home field for our community's lacrosse teams.
